**Organizing Authority:** MBYC

**RULES:** The regatta will be governed by rules as defined by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and the following rules. In the event of a conflict between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply.

**SAFETY:** USCG-Approved Life jackets shall be worn at all times on the water, except for brief periods when adjusting clothing or equipment. Additional safety rules may be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

**BOW NUMBER RULE:** Bow numbers are required for each InterClub. All InterClub dinghies shall have the same sail number as their bow number. If two yachts have the same "bow/sail" numbers, the boat whose hull's number matches that "bow/sail" number shall display that number. The bow number shall be placed within 1 foot of the bow stem. In addition, the bow number must be of contrasting color to the hull. Bow numbers will not be supplied by the organizing authority.

**IC DINGHY WEIGHT RULES:** The "National" crew/boat rules will apply per the IC Technical regulations for the InterClub Dinghy Class Minimum crew weight: 315lbs. This changes IC Technical regulations for the InterClub Dinghy Class

**IDEAL 18 CREW:** Ideal 18s may be sailed with a crew of two or three. This changes Ideal 18 Class rule 13.4.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** The Manhasset Bay Yacht Club cordially invites all InterClub, Penguin, Ideal 18, Lasers, Sunfish, and other frostbite one-design class sailors to compete in the New Years Frostbite Regatta. All **Past Commodores of the Frostbite Yacht Club** are invited to sail in the Past Commodores' Race.

**ENTRIES:** **Pre-registration is encouraged.** Entry fee is \$50 for US SAILING members and \$65 for non-US SAILING members, payable to MBYC. **On-line Registration is available.** **On site** registration will be from **10:00 am - 11:30 pm** on Friday, January 1, at the Manhasset Bay Yacht Club.

**RACING AREA:** The racing area will be Manhasset Bay.

**MEASUREMENT:** It is the responsibility of every competitor to make sure his or her boat, sail, and equipment measure to the current IC Technical regulations for the InterClub Dinghy Class or as prescribed by the Measurement Committee. In order for a competitor to complete registration, each Interclub shall submit a completed Interclub Measurement Certificate that is signed by their respective fleet measurer. In addition, the skipper and the crew will be required to weigh in before their final registration will be accepted.

**COURSES:** Courses will be windward/leeward or no-jibe type short courses.

**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Sailing Instructions will be available during registration/check in hours and will be posted on the Internet on the Manhasset Bay YC site at [www.manhassetbayyc.org](http://www.manhassetbayyc.org).

**SCORING:** The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A, will be used, except that no score shall be excluded (no throwout). A DNF will be scored as the number of finishers plus two. This changes RRS A5.

**PRIZES:**

The Baker-Taylor Founders Trophy will be awarded for the highest percentage in any class.  
 The Henry A. Alker Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding MBYC skipper.  
 The San Wetherill Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding InterClub skipper.  
 The Geoffery C. Hazzard Frostbite Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding Penguin skipper.  
 The John P. Barry Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the outstanding Ideal 18 skipper.  
 The Robert W. Fraser Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Past Commodore's Race.  
 The Anchor Light Trophy for participation will also be awarded.

Appropriate trophies will be awarded in each class.
